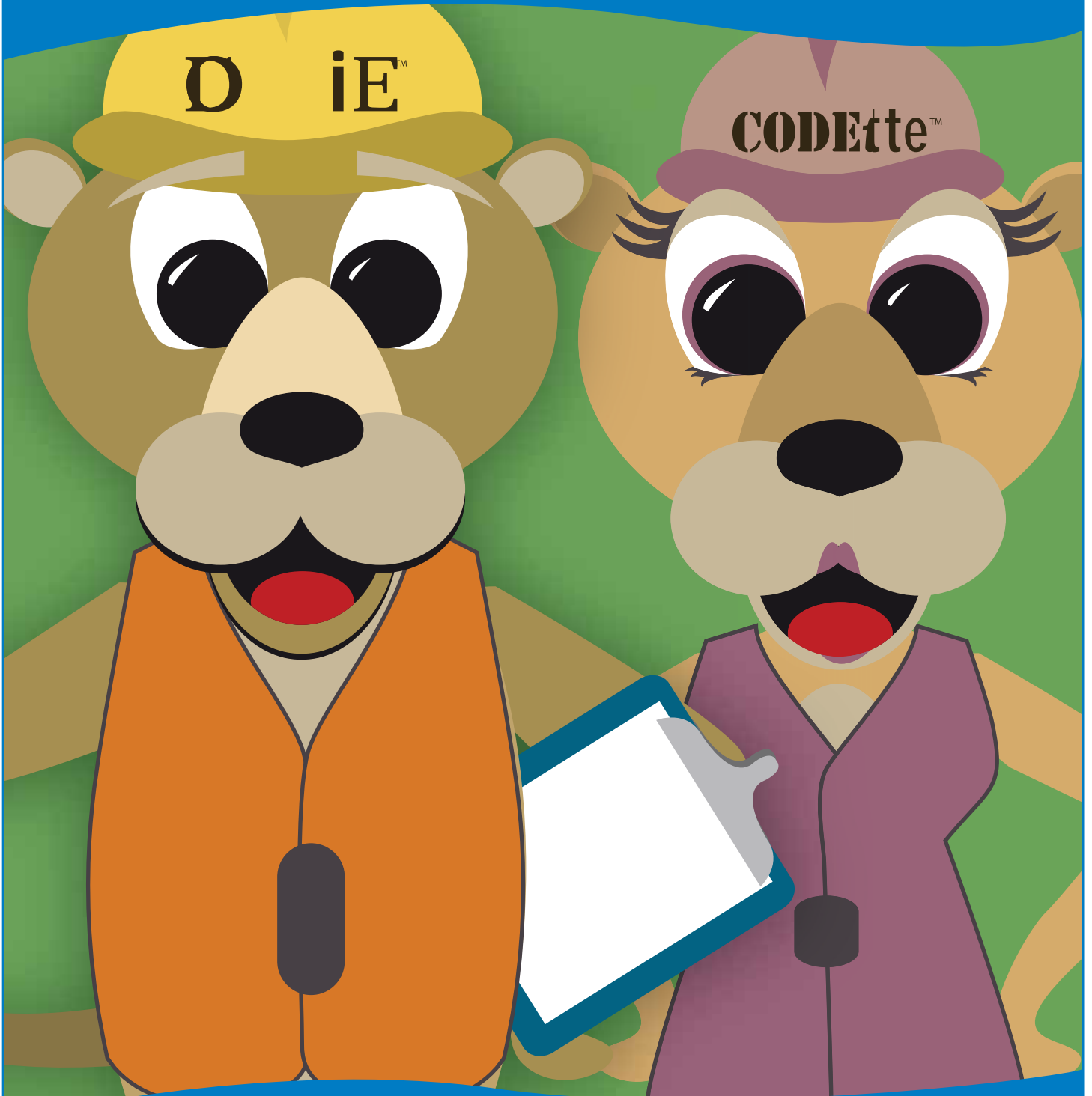

# Hi!

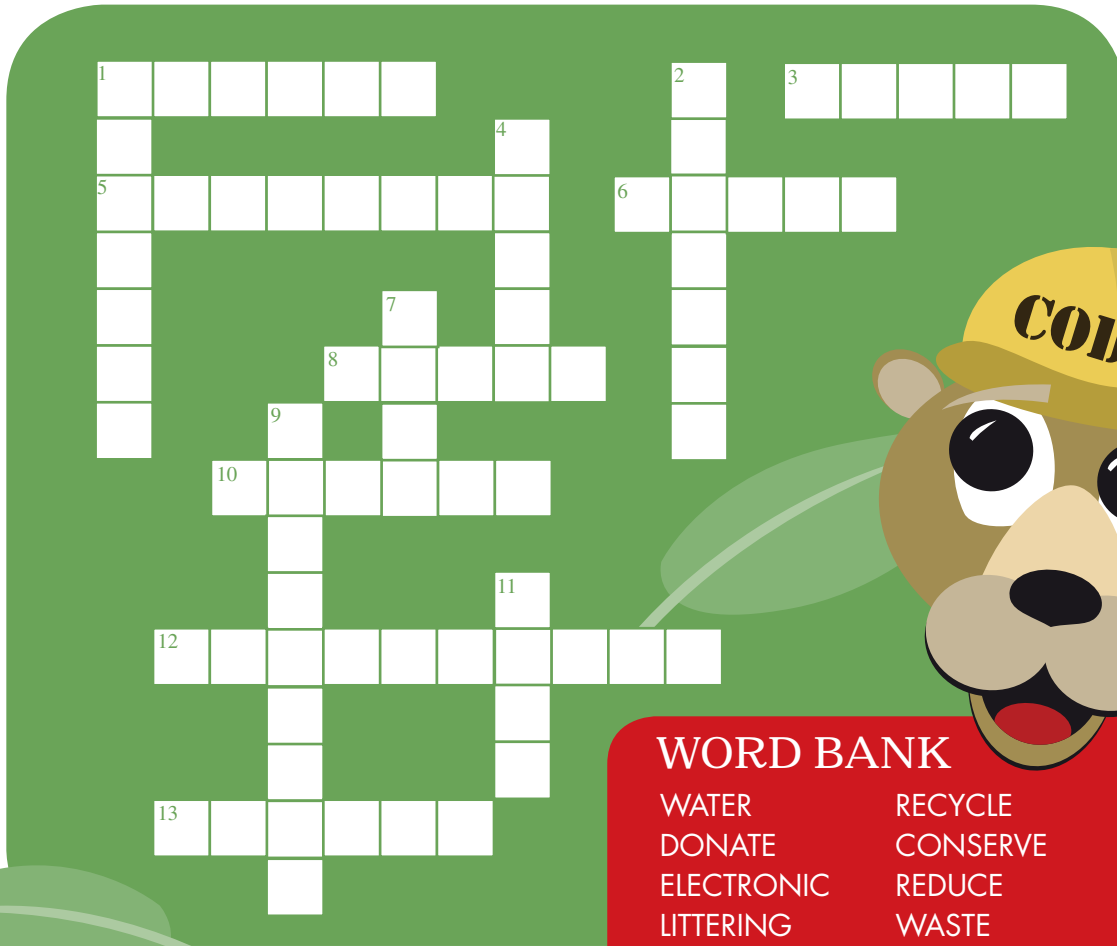

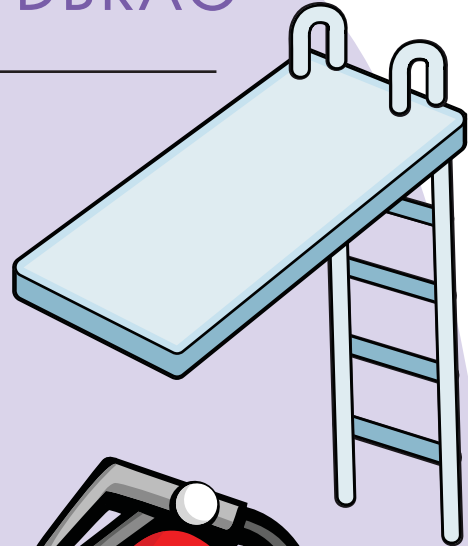

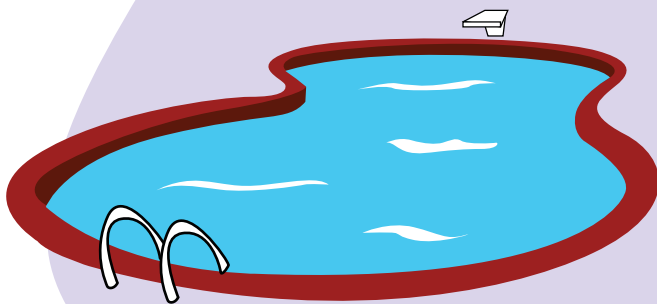

# Safety Kit Fun



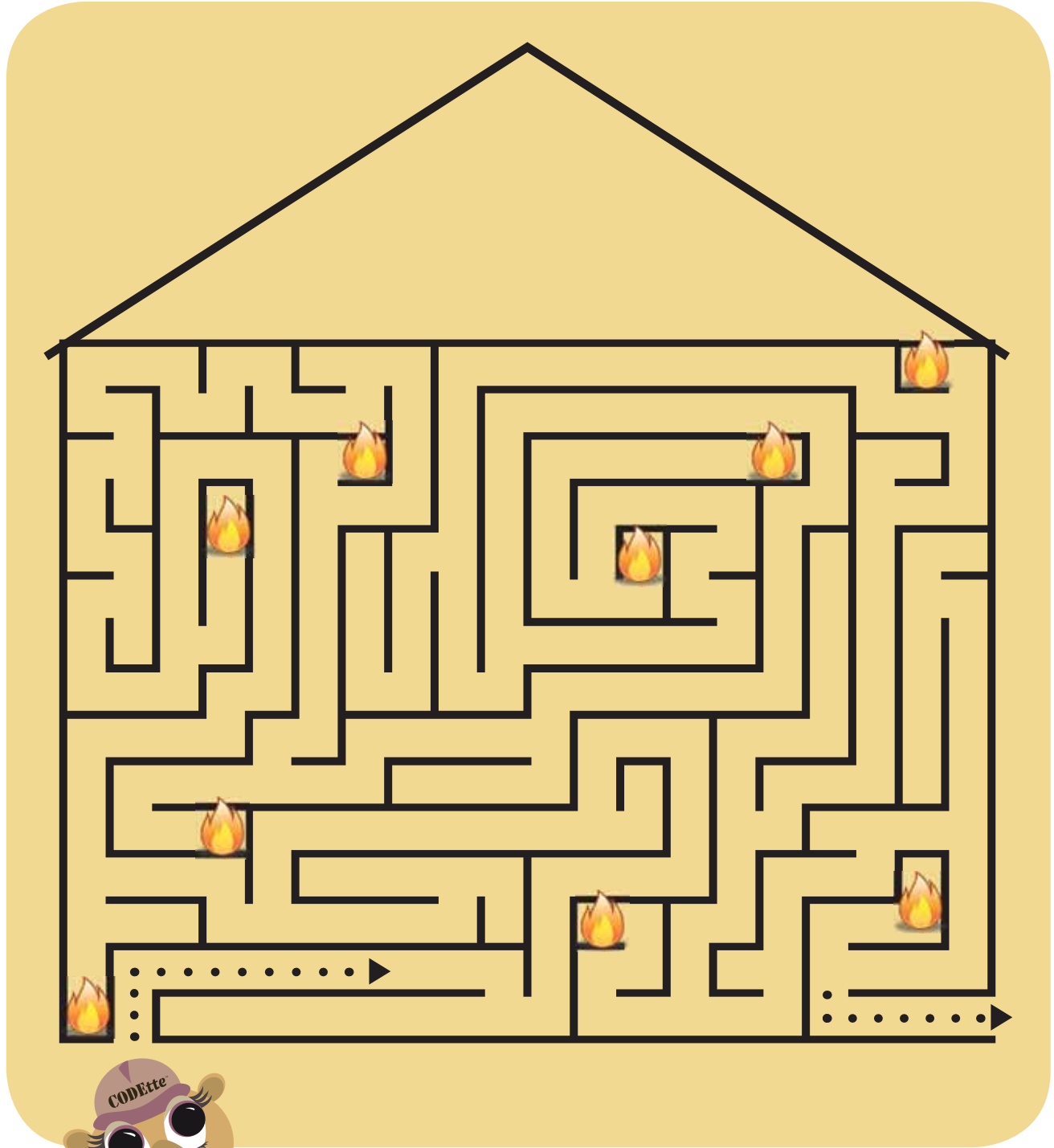
Be sure to always have a safety kit around the house in case of bad weather and circle 10 items CODiE should put in his kit.

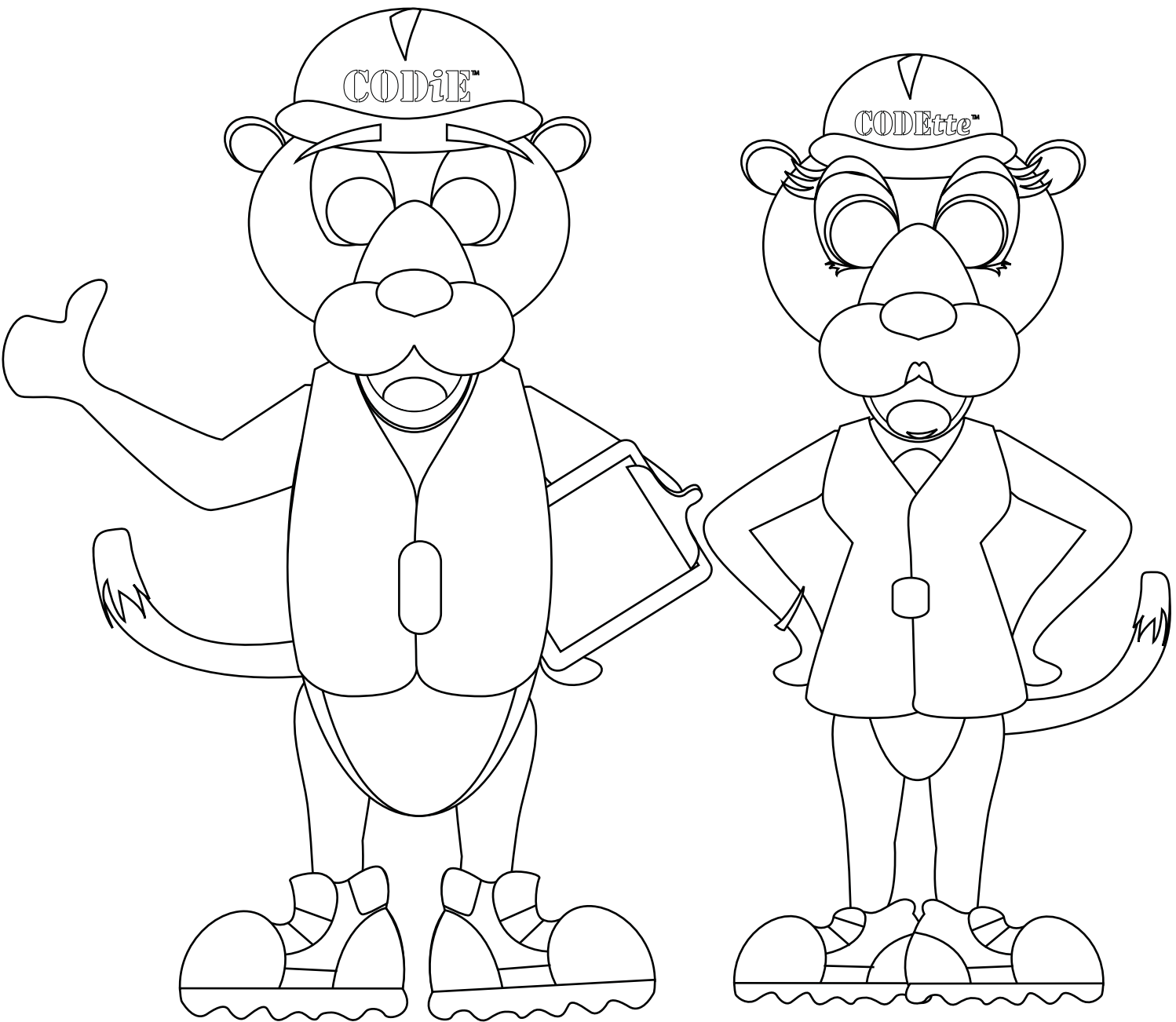

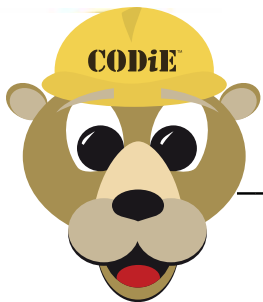
