

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-0420B

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMER, TEXAS PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF THE NEW MASTER FEE SCHEDULE FOR ALL FEES AND CHARGES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED BY THE CITY, WHICH IS ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmer desires to adopt an updated Master Fee Schedule to provide for the fees and charges assessed and collected by the City; and

WHEREAS, after consideration and review, the City Council finds that the Master Fee Schedule, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMER, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** That a Master Fee Schedule, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", be, and the same is, hereby adopted to provide for fees and charges assessed and collected by the City.

**SECTION 2.** That all provisions of any resolution of the City Council of the City of Wilmer in conflict with the provisions of this resolution be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective and after its passage, as the law in such cases provide.


